

Career inventory tests are available through the Counseling Center, Room 2410, West Campus. There are no "right" or "wrong" answers or passing or failing with these instruments. Two different career inventories are available **online** – the Strong Interest Inventory (SII) and the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI). You may access these tests by going to the Century College Homepage under **Current Students → GPS Lifeplan/View Your LifePlan → Career Plan → Step 1: Assess Yourself → Interests and/or Personality → SII and/or MBTI.**

Other career inventories, which are listed on the reverse side of this handout, are available through the Counseling and Career Center located in Room 2410 on the West Campus. **Before testing, it is recommended that you talk with a counselor to determine which tests will be appropriate for you.**

If you will be taking a paper and pencil test, **pay for the test(s) at the business office and obtain a receipt** for the amount of the testing fee. (If the Business Office is closed, you may pay the Counseling Center Receptionist [by check only] and obtain your receipt.) Bring the receipt to the Counseling Center Receptionist and take the tests. Testing is available from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Friday. No appointment is necessary to take the tests. You will be notified by mail when the tests have been scored (about 2 weeks) so that you can make an appointment for an interpretation. You may wish to schedule the appointment for an interpretation at the time you take the test(s).



**In order to receive your results for the online version of the SII and/or the MBTI, you must pay the testing fee at the Business Office located in room 2340 of the West Campus. The cost for the SII is \$7.30 and the cost for the MBTI is \$9.65.** After obtaining a receipt from the Business Office, you may bring a receipt to the Counseling and Career Center to set up an appointment for interpretation of your results with a counselor. See the Counseling and Career Center website for center hours.

**Note:** please read the instructions on the front page of the test booklet before starting. To increase the validity of your results, read the instructions for each section of the test **before** you answer the questions.

_____	<b>Career Decision-Making System (CDMS):</b> A self-scoring tool for career planning. Covers interests, values and abilities. Results in specific job choices and job clusters. Immediate Results.	<b>\$2.48</b>
_____	<b>Career Assessment Inventory, Vocational Version (CAI):</b> Interest inventory that compares your interests to those of people working in diverse occupations. Tends to focus on occupations that require vocational/technical training or less than two years of college. Includes some occupations that require more college. Does not measure abilities or aptitudes.	<b>\$7.00</b>
_____	<b>Career Assessment Inventory, Enhanced Version (CAI):</b> Similar to the CAI Vocational Version described above, but includes more occupations involving college and fewer requiring vocational/technical training. Also contains more questions of a non-technical nature.	<b>\$7.00</b>
_____	<b>Strong Interest Inventory (SII):</b> Widely researched interest inventory that compares your interests with those of people in a broad range of occupations. Emphasizes occupations that require college or are related to college. Does not measure abilities or aptitudes.	<b>Paper Version \$7.90 Online Version \$7.30</b>
_____	<b>Myers-Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI):</b> Measures personal preferences that influence your learning and work style. Understanding your style can improve your education/career planning, performance, and satisfaction.	<b>Form Q \$18.90 Step II Profile Online M Version \$9.65</b>
_____	<b>Campbell Interest and Skill Survey (CISS):</b> Analyzes your self-reported interests and skills and shows how they compare to the general population and to people employed in a variety of occupations. Price includes Interest/Skills Patterns workbook. <b>Only recommended for students with significant work experience and a clear understanding of their occupational skills.</b>	<b>\$9.50</b>

**Note:** Counselors give individual or group interpretations (one hour per test) to current and returning Century College students.

**Individual interpretations:** 2<sup>nd</sup> week of September through 1<sup>st</sup> week of November and 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January through 1<sup>st</sup> week of April

**Group interpretations:** Every 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of November, December and April, May, June, July and August
