



3.17.0.5 Academic Renewal

A student attending Century may file an Academic Petition requesting academic forgiveness of previous Century grades under the following conditions:

1. Student has returned to Century after a five-year lapse of attendance at Century.
2. Student must be in attendance at Century at the time of the petition.

When the above conditions are met, the student must petition the Vice President of Academic Affairs for evaluation.

1. A Century degree audit or transcript must be attached.
2. Student may request that up to 45 quarter credits or 30 semester credits of F or NC grades earned at Century be omitted from the GPA calculation.
3. Student must state the courses to be forgiven.

If the petition is approved, the Registrar will adjust the student's record. All forgiven courses will remain on the academic record. The symbol of "F*" will replace the forgiven grades. This change will be reflected in the credits attempted and the grade point average for both the term and the cumulative GPA.
