



### 5.18.0.1 Alcoholic Beverages

The use, possession, distribution, manufacture or sale of any alcoholic beverage is prohibited on the Century College campus. This campus prohibition includes and applies to any person on campus grounds, whether he or she is a member of the campus community or not. Individuals should note that even though they may be of legal age to consume or possess alcohol, campus and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities policies and procedures prohibit the use or possession of alcohol on the campus except as specifically noted in Minnesota State Colleges and Universities policy 5.18 and 5.18.1.

#### **Sanctions: Students**

Students who violate this policy on alcoholic beverages are subject to college sanctions which may include, but are not limited to:

- Referral for assessment or counseling
  - Disciplinary warning, probation, suspension, and/or expulsion
  - Restitution
- (See Century Student Conduct Policy 3.6.01.)

#### **Sanctions: Employees**

Employees who violate this policy are subject to disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion or termination of employment. Employees with alcohol problems may be referred to the Employee Assistance Program or elsewhere for assessment and/or counseling.

#### **Exceptions:**

Use of alcohol in laboratory and classroom instruction/experiments
