Admissions Guidelines:

St. Thomas admits students on a first come, first served basis. Applications are reviewed as they arrive, as soon as they are determined to be complete. The sooner you apply the better. An early application can facilitate an earlier registration time for classes.

St. Thomas will consider applications from students who have attained a grade-point average of at least 2.3 in transferable baccalaureate-level courses.

Although we do not have an application deadline, we do encourage students to apply by August 1 for fall semester and January 1 for spring semester. Generally, students are notified of acceptance within three weeks of completing their application.

Notes:

Students will be required to fulfill general education requirements as published in the catalog of the year they enroll at the University of St. Thomas.

St. Thomas requires 84 credits outside the major department (76 credits for business majors), and a total of 132 credits for graduation. Students must complete 32 of their last 36 credits at St. Thomas, as stated in the Senior Residency Requirement.

The Transfer Academic Recognition Award (TARA)

Newly-admitted St. Thomas transfer students who have obtained a 2.8 GPA or higher in transferable college course work from a regionally accredited college or university are eligible to apply. For more information, contact the Office of Undergraduate Financial Aid.

The University of St. Thomas will send an application to all qualified prospective transfer students. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis and recipients will be selected until the Transfer Academic Recognition Award funds are exhausted.
