General Education Requirements

Transfer with an Associate in Arts Degree (AA) or Minnesota Transfer Curriculum:

Students who complete the Associate in Arts degree or the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) at Century College will have met the general education requirements at the University of North Dakota (UND). Students are still required to complete any general education requirements specific to their major. Consult with a Century College counselor for this information.

Transfer without an AA or MNTC Completed:

Students should choose Century College courses from each category listed below and **include the following Special Emphasis Requirements:** One quantitative reasoning course (designated with a Q), two social-cultural diversity courses, one designated with a U and addressing diversity within the United States, and one designated with a G and addressing global diversity, and one advanced communication course (numbered 200 or higher and designated with an A).

Application Deadlines: Rolling Application Policy: Priority deadline of April 15 for Transfer Scholarship. Early application also ensures student access to the Transfer Getting Started Program (dates of the program are posted at <http://gettingstarted.und.edu/transfer>).

Application Information:

1. A minimum transfer GPA of 2.0 is required.
2. All courses numbered 1000 or higher will transfer. Students are cautioned that all credits transferred may not fit within specific degree requirements. Transfer students are required to complete a minimum of 60 credits at four-year institutions and the last 30 credits at UND. A minimum of 125 credits is required for a baccalaureate degree.
3. If a student has fewer than 60 transferable credits, a high school transcript is required for application to UND.
4. If a student has fewer than 24 transferable credits and is less than 25 years of age, official ACT or SAT test scores are required.
