



CENTURY COLLEGE COURSE SELECTION GUIDE COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD & ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCES

Sections I and II list courses applicable to General Education and Other University-Wide Requirements. Section III provides additional information for majors in the College of Agriculture, Food & Environmental Sciences (CAFES) at UW-River Falls.

I. GENERAL EDUCATION

Listed below are Century College courses most directly applicable to the UW-River Falls Gen Ed requirements. Students may also check for updates to the Gen Ed and program requirements in the on-line UW-RF catalog at: www.uwrf.edu/catalog.

- A. Communication – Reading and Writing (CW):** ENGL 1021
- B. Communication – Advanced (CA):** ENGL 1022
- C. Communication – Speaking and Listening (CS):** SPCH 1021 (Business or Marketing Comm majors take BMGT 2060)
- D. Humanities and Fine Arts (HF): Select one course from two different areas.**

 - 2. ENGL 2011, 2012, 2031, 2032, 2051, 2052 (Literature is required for all teacher education majors)

- E. Social and Behavioral Sciences (SB): Select one course from 2 different areas:**
 - 1. ANTH 1021, 1023
 - 2. BMGT 1030
 - 3. GEOG 1023, 1031
 - 4. HIST 1021, 1022, 1031, 1032, 1051, 1061
 - 5. POLS 1020, 1023, 1031
 - 6. PSYC 1020
 - 7. SOC 1020
 - 8. ANTH/PSYC/SOC 1000
- F. Sciences (S) and Sciences with Lab (SL): Select one course from two of the following areas, at least one with lab.** Many CAFES majors require more supporting sciences. Consult UW-RF catalog or CAFES websites.
 - 1. BIOL 1020, 1041 (BIOL 1041 required for most CAFES majors)
 - 2. CHEM 1020, 1041 (CHEM 1041 required for all CAFES majors)
 - 3. GEOG 1021
 - 4. Geology/Earth Science: NATS 1020, 1030, 1060 (NATS 1030 required for Geology or Conservation majors)
 - 5. Physics/Astronomy: PHYS 1021, 1041, 1070 (optional lab 1075), 1081) (PHYS 1041 or 1081 required for Ag. Engineering Tech. & Food Science majors)
- G. Mathematics (M):**
 - 1. MATH 1061 or higher required for all CAFES majors.
- H. Personal Health and Wellness (HW) and Health/Physical Activity (HA):** This includes a wellness/healthy lifestyle component (HW) and a physical activity (HA) component.
 - 1. Courses which meet the entire HW and HA requirement (2 credits): PE 1060, 1063, 1067, 1070, 1073, 1075.
 - 2. Courses which meet the HW component only: HLTH 1020, 1040, 1070.
 - 3. Courses which meet the HA component only: Any 1 credit PE activity course (PE 1000 - 1075)
- I. Ethical Citizenship (EC):** Select one course from BIOL 1028, BIOL 1026, SPCH 1061

Students who complete the Associate of Arts Degree are considered to have satisfied UW-RF Gen Ed, except for a junior/senior level “Multidisciplinary Inquiry” course, and any specific college, major or professional licensure requirements.

II. OTHER UNIVERSITY-WIDE REQUIREMENTS

These courses may double count in any area of the UW-RF degree.

- A. UW System Ethnic/Cultural Diversity Requirement** (One course) The typical courses in this category are history or literature courses related to U.S minority cultures.
- B. UW-RF Global Perspectives Requirement** (One course) A course at the sophomore level or higher, which examines subject matter from a global/international perspective. This is usually taken at UW-RF.

III. MAJOR/MINOR COURSES Additional courses should be selected based on the intended subject area major/minor. Consult the UW-RF web site (www.uwrf.edu) for links to academic departments, program requirements and the catalog.

A. College of Agriculture, Food & Environmental Science (CAFES) Majors.

- 1. Transfer after one year is recommended for students planning for transfer to most CAFES programs. Students should give priority to the Gen Ed communications, science and math requirements prior to transfer.

2. Horticulture Majors. The UW-RF CAFES Plant & Earth Science Department will allow up to 18 credits of Century College Horticulture courses to apply to the UW-RF Horticulture major. Additional Horticulture credit may be accepted as general elective. Century Horticulture courses are accepted as follows:
