## DEGREES AVAILABLE IN THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS ARE:

- Bachelor of Accounting
- Bachelor of Business Administration with majors in:
  - Finance
  - Human Resource Management
  - Organizational Management
  - Management Information Systems
  - Marketing
  - Health Care Management

A major in economics is offered through the College of Liberal Arts as a Bachelor of Arts degree. Students must follow the degree requirements for the BA degree and declare a minor or double major.

- Math 1025, 1050 and 1070 (Students can opt for Math 1081 and 1082 instead of Math 1070.)
- Psyc 1020
- Comm 1021 or 1031

## LIBERAL EDUCATION AND LOWER DIVISION ELECTIVES:

In addition to fulfilling the prerequisite and supporting courses, the other lower division courses (to total 60 credits) must all be liberal education and non-SBE electives. Students should be advised, however, that there is very little room for electives in the Accounting and Business Administration degrees

## TRANSFER WITH AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS (AA) DEGREE OR THE MINNESOTA TRANSFER CURRICULUM (MnTC):

Students who have earned the AA degree or the MnTC will be considered to have met UMD's liberal education requirements.

## TRANSFER WITHOUT AN AA DEGREE OR THE MnTC:

Students who transfer without an AA degree or the MnTC must meet [UMD's Liberal Education](#) requirements.

## **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

### **Fewer than 26 credits: (Admission to the University, not SBE)**

- (a) A high school rank at or above the 50th percentile,
- (b) A grade point average of at least 1.80 in your college coursework,
- (c) Successful completion of at least 75% of all college work attempted.

### **More than 20 attempted credits: (Admission to the University and SBE)**

- (a) A grade point average of a minimum of 2.00 for all college courses. (If you have completed 60 or more credits you will need an overall GPA of 2.00, as well as a 2.00 GPA in all accounting, business law, economics, finance, and management information sciences and management studies.)
- (b) Completed all pre-major requirements.

***To be considered for candidacy or entrance to the School of Business and Economics, a floating GPA requirement is used.***

## **NOTES:**

- No more than 50% of the 120 credits needed to graduate may be in accounting, business or economics. Transfer students should limit courses in these areas to those listed as pre-major requirements.
- As least one year of college level foreign language is encouraged.
