Who use the International Student Application?

- Foreign students living abroad who wish to receive and I-20 form to study at Century College.
- Non-immigrant aliens currently in the US with any type of visa who wish to change their status to F-1 student visa. Additional documentation may need to be submitted to the immigration service.
- Non-immigrant aliens currently in the US with any type of visa (B, F, H, J, etc) and applicants for political asylum. **If you are not trying to change your current visa to a student visa, please submit the “short form” of the International Student Application. B and F-2 visa holders must apply for a change of non-immigrant visa status through the immigration service and must have approval prior to attending classes.**

US Citizens, Permanent Residents, Refugees, Asylees and Nationals use the regular Century College application for admissions.
