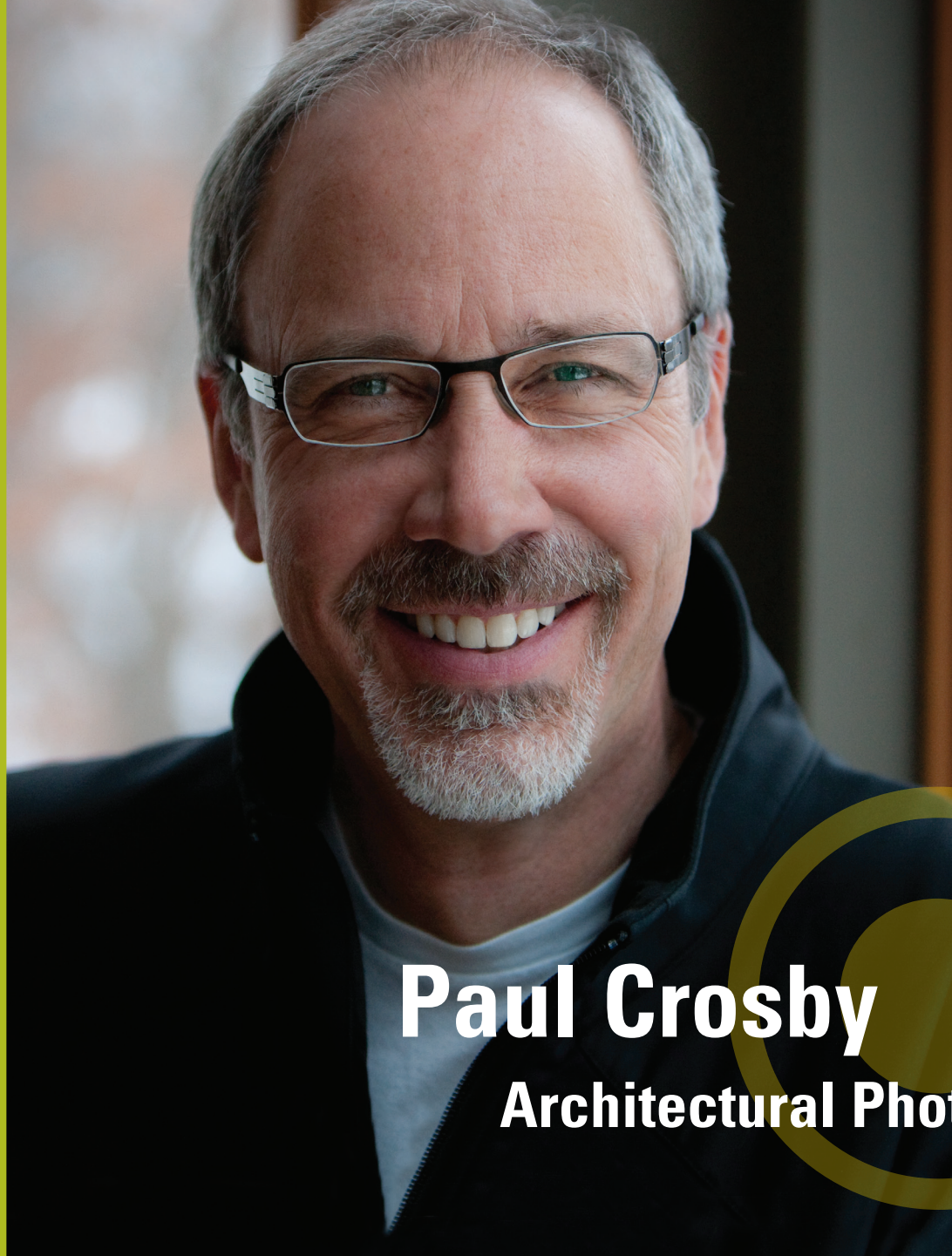


“Finding a Path Through the Lens”

After studying design and photography at the Minneapolis College of Art and Brooks Institute of Photography in Santa Barbara, Paul opened a commercial studio in Minneapolis, doing primarily product shooting for a wide range of clients including companies such as 3M, Best Buy, Cargill, Dairy Queen, Deluxe Corporation, Imation, Jostens, Marvin Windows, SuperValu, Target and others.

In 2006 he made a decision to follow a long time interest, shifted his career to architectural photography, and currently shoots primarily for architects and large construction companies. The shift to an all-location work-style has required travel to locations throughout the USA and as far away as Beirut, Lebanon.

Throughout his career, he has maintained a connection to his personal work. His fine art photography has been published in domestic and international photography journals, as well as shown and represented by galleries in the USA and abroad.
