FALL SEMESTER 2009 PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The 2009 Century College Leadership Institute theme is "Exploring Self, Exploring Groups, and Exploring the World." Highlights of the ten-week-long program include the following:

EXPLORING SELF

- **Week One** - Welcome and Introductions and Ice Breakers!
- **Week Two (Discovering your Leadership Style)** - This workshop will focus on exploring different leadership theories and your personal leadership style through assessments and group discussion.
- **Week Three (Create your Marketing Package)** - You will be introduced to and have a chance to activate your eFolio account, an electronic portfolio designed to showcase your personal and educational accomplishments.
- **Week Four (Doing the Right Thing: Skills for Ethical Leadership)** - In this workshop, you will be introduced to ethical issues encountered in college and in the workforce and identify the difference between what a person "wants to" do and "should" do.

EXPLORING GROUPS

- **Week Five (There's No "I" in Team: Cultivating Group Development)** – A team can only be as effective as its individual members. Learn your personality style through assessment and what it takes to build a high functioning team.
- **Week Six (Cool your Jets: Dealing with Difficult People)** - Through discussion and group activities you will learn how to deal with difficult people and situations.
- **Week Seven (Networking 101: The Do's and Don'ts)** - This session will offer you the opportunity to learn how to network face to face and how to use social networking tools to your benefit.

EXPLORING THE WORLD

- **Week Eight (Got Culture? What Does Cultural Identity have to do With Leadership?)** - This interactive workshop will take participants on an exploration regarding the important role culture plays in shaping the next generation of leaders
- **Week Nine (Exploring Differences: Diversity, Multiculturalism and Social Justice)** - Interactive discussions and activities will facilitate learning about diversity, multiculturalism and social justice. Participants will assess their personal philosophies and how that influences their leadership.
