



Student Success Day **Information for Students**

Student Success Day will be held **Tuesday, February 7, 2012.**

Century College is committed to helping ALL students be successful in pursuing their academic goals. This day is set aside each semester in order to focus on and promote student success.

Students are expected to attend school on Student Success Day, February 7th, and participate in the following activities:

- Attend conferences with their instructors to review their academic progress and address any concerns related to academic progress.
- Attend presentations/workshops focused on various aspects of the GPS Lifeplans: education, career, personal, finance, and leadership.
- Attend keynote presentation at 12:00 PM and/or 5:00 PM focused on student success topics. This event is sponsored by Student Life.
- Visit open houses, walk-in counseling, and open gymnasium/intramural.

Expectation for classes on February 7:

- **Day Classes, starting before 3:00 PM on Student Success Day:** Day classes that are scheduled before 3:00 PM will not meet on Student Success Day. Students are expected to attend Student Success Day activities (see above options) between 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM.
- **Late Afternoon Classes** Starting at 3pm or LATER on Student Success Day will devote the first hour of class to conferences with the instructor or activities planned by the instructor.
- **There are no evening classes on February 7th because of the Precinct Caucuses.**

During Student Success Week, February 6 – February 11:

- **Late Afternoon and/or Evening Classes, starting at 3:00 PM or later on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday during Student Success Week:** In keeping with the goals of Student Success Day, late afternoon and evening classes on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday of Student Success Week will devote the first hour of class to conferences or student success activities planned by instructors.
- **Saturday Classes during Student Success Week:** In keeping with the goals of Student Success Day, Saturday classes during Student Success Week will devote the first hour of class to conferences or student success activities planned by instructors.
