The complete Minnesota Transfer Curriculum and Liberal Arts Associate of Arts degrees are fully accepted general education requirements. Also, individually completed goal areas completed within the MnTC will transfer toward individual general education requirements at Concordia University St. Paul.

Concordia University, St. Paul welcomes and encourages students to apply for admission for both fall and spring semesters.

What are the admission requirements?

- Minimum 2.00 cumulative grade point average
- Letter of recommendation from the dean of students of the college or university you last attended
- Official transcripts from all colleges or universities you have attended

Does Concordia accept the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum?

Yes! Transfer students who have completed the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum or an Associate of Arts degree from an accredited institution are considered to have met Concordia's general education requirements with the exception of two religion classes (8 credits.) Concordia University also **accepts individual goal areas completed within the MnTC.**

Will I need to submit high school transcripts or ACT scores?

Transfer students with 20 or more college semester credits are not required to submit high school transcripts, ACT or SAT scores.

What are the most popular areas of study at Concordia University?

Concordia's most popular areas of study in our traditional programs are business, education, communication, church work, psychology, theater and science majors. Concordia also offers a variety of educational options for individuals looking to complete BA degrees in an accelerated evening or online format. These programs can take a little as 16–22 months to complete; attending class one night per week. What merit scholarships and grants are available?

Transfer students are awarded one of four scholarships (renewable for two additional years) based on cumulative GPA at the time of admission. The Transfer Regents Scholarship is an \$8,000 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 3.25 GPA or higher. The Transfer President's Scholarship is a \$5,500 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 3.0-3.249 GPA. The Transfer University Scholarship is a \$4,500 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 2.5-2.9 GPA. The Transfer Concordia Opportunity Grant is a \$2,500 scholarship that is awarded to those who demonstrate a 2.0-2.49 GPA. A transfer student who receives one of these awards must have completed a minimum of 20 semester credits prior to entering Concordia University, and attend full-time in the undergraduate traditional program to qualify.

*All Century College graduates earning an AA, AS, or AAS transferring to Concordia to complete a Bachelor's Degree are awarded the Transfer Advantage Scholarship, \$1000 per year for two years, for a total of \$2,000.

Concordia University maps the MNSCU Transfer Curriculum as noted below. Note if a student **completes** a MNSCU goal area they meet the related General Education requirement of Concordia University noted in the left column below.

If a student does not complete the MNSCU Goal area they will need to complete specific courses as noted in the college specific transfer guide at (enter website). In **general** a student should choose a course in the Goal Area that is in the same discipline as Concordia's equivalent course. If needed, students can reach a counselor at Concordia to help with this process by calling 651-641-8230.
