CENTURY COLLEGE COURSES THAT MEET PRE-CHIROPRACTIC CURRICULUM REQUIREMENTS:

Biology: 2 semesters of animal or vertebrate biology with lab. Not less than 6 semester credits.

Suggested courses: BIOL 1041, 1042, 2031, 2032, 2035, 2040, 2045

Chemistry: CHEM 1041, 1042, 2041, 2042 (Biochemistry with lab is acceptable but not available at Century College)

English/Communication Skills: 6 semester credits in English Composition, Literature, or COMM/Speech

PHYSICS: 1 semester of Physics I with lab is required. The second semester may be completed by taking Physics II; or by completing 3 credits of one of the following: Biomechanics, Kinesiology, Exercise Physiology, or math-based Statistics.

Required portion:

Phys 1041 General Physics I

One of the following:

Phys 1042 General Physics II

Math 1025 Statistics

Psychology: PSYC 1020

Social Sciences/ Humanities: Not less than 15 semester credits. Electives in sociology, humanities, political science, philosophy, history, anthropology, religion, etc. Call Northwestern if you have a course in question.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Grade of "C" or better in each required course
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.50
- Science grade point average of 2.00
- CUMULATIVE CREDITS: 90 cumulative semester credits needed for admission. Recommended courses include the following: Medical Terminology (Century's HLTH 1001) Human Anatomy, General Physiology, Cell Biology, Cell Physiology, Immunology, Genetics, Macroeconomics, Marketing, Small Business Management, Public Speaking, Technical Writing, and Medical Terminology. Math as needed for other science courses.
- New students are admitted January and September. Apply 9 to 12 months in advance of the term you wish to enter. The program can be completed in as little as 3 years and 4 months. This is a full time day program only (five days per week).
