### Transferring from Century College to the College of St. Catherine

#### Majors and Concentrations

The College of St. Catherine has a superb reputation in the business community and offers the following majors and concentrations within the Business Administration department. You may complete either the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree through either the **Day** or **Weekend College** options.

- Accounting
- Business Administration (Marketing/Management or Small Business/Entrepreneurship concentrations)
- Information Systems (Day Program only)
- Management Information Systems (Weekend College only)
- Sales (Business-to-Business Sales, Financial Services Sales, or Medical Sales concentrations)

#### Required Supporting Coursework

There are required "supporting" courses for the business majors that vary slightly by concentration. The following chart lists the required supporting coursework for the **Accounting** and **Business Administration** majors. See St. Kate's catalog for more details.

#### Major Coursework

Major requirements for each concentration also vary, although there are a core group of courses listed below that are generally required regardless of your concentration (once again, the following chart lists courses required for the **Accounting** and **Business Administration** majors).
