ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY GENERAL EDUCATION

TRANSFER WITH AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS (AA) DEGREE or COMPLETED MnTC:

Students who transfer with an Associate in Arts (AA) Degree or a completed Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) will have satisfied the general education requirements at St. Cloud State University, *with the exception of the 1 credit Physical Education course*. However, specific general education courses are sometimes required for a major. This transfer agreement does not waive those requirements. Transfer students are encouraged to consult Century College counselors, St. Cloud State University transfer advisors, and the SCSU website when planning for a specific major.

TRANSFER WITHOUT AN ASSOCIATE IN ARTS DEGREE or COMPLETED MnTC:

If neither the Associate in Arts Degree (AA) nor the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) is completed, a transfer student has a choice of two general education systems at St. Cloud State University. The Advising Center at St. Cloud State provides assistance in deciding which program to complete. The two 40 credit options are 1) the broad SCSU General Education program and 2) completion of St. Cloud State's 10 Minnesota Transfer Curriculum competencies.

Option One: SCSU GENERAL EDUCATION PROGRAM:

I. Core (16 semester credits)

- Core 1:** ENGL 1021 and 1022
- Core 2:** SPCH 1021
- Core 3:** MATH 1050 or 1061 or 1070 or 1081 (Consider requirements for major.)
- Core 4:** PHIL 1041
- Core 5:** POLS 1031

II. Distribution (minimum of 24 semester credits)

In two areas, take nine credits, at least six credits from departments in the left-hand column and no more than four credits from departments in the right-hand column. All nine may come from departments in the left-hand column. No more than 4 credits may be taken from any department.

In one area, take six credits, all from departments in the left-hand column. This "short" area must be approved by your adviser. No more than 4 credits may be taken from any department.

Area A: Humanities/Fine Arts

No more than 4 credits from the following:

Area B: Natural Sciences:

Choose 6-9 credits from the following:

- Include one laboratory course
- BIOL 1020, 1024, 1025, 1026, 1028
- CHEM 1020, 1030, 1041
- GEOG 1021
- NSCI 1020, 1030, 1050, 1060
- PHYS 1021, 1041, 1070/75, 1081

No more than 4 credits from the following:

- ENGR 1020
- MATH 1030, 1070

Area C: Social and Behavioral Sciences:

Choose 6-9 credits from the following:

III. University Requirements

Racial Issues/Diversity - Multicultural, Gender, and Minority Studies (MGM)

Each student must complete three MGM courses. No more than 1 course from any one department. One course must be an approved Racial Issues course to be taken in the first year of enrollment.

The Racial Issues/ Diversity requirement is waived for transfers with the AA degree or **completed MnTC** (40 credits.) Students transferring with less than 20 General Education credits will be required to complete all nine credits in this category, those with 20-29 General Education credits, 6 credits, and those with 30-39 General Education credits, 3 credits. One Racial Issues course must be completed. The courses must be from different departments.

Physical Education

Each student must complete a 1-credit course in wellness and fitness.

Choose one course: PE 1060, 1070

(Transfer with the AA degree or MnTC completed does not waive this requirement.)

Option Two: The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum at SCSU

General Information:

This option is intended for transfer students who may have completed only part of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum at Century or another college or university. If an entire goal is completed prior to transfer it will be considered fulfilled at SCSC as well. Individual MnTC courses will transfer into the same goal awarded by the sending institution. The SCSU University Requirements outlined above must also be met to complete SCSU's MTC.

Requirements: (Minimum of 40 credits total)

Consult the Century guide sheet for the AA degree or the Century MnTC Course List for course options.

GOAL 1: Communications – 7 credits ENGL 1021 & 1022(Complete both prior to transfer) & SPCH 1021

GOAL 2: Critical Thinking – 3 credits Phil 1041

GOAL 3: Natural Sciences - Minimum of two courses, 6-8 credits, one lab course, no more than 4 credits per dept.

GOAL 4: Mathematical/Logical Reasoning – 3 credits

GOAL 5: History and the Social and Behavioral Sciences – Minimum 3 credits

GOAL 6: Humanities and the Fine Arts – Minimum 6 credits, no more than 3 credits from one department, one course must be from the arts and the other from the humanities.

GOAL 7: Human Diversity – Minimum 3 credits

GOAL 8: Global Perspectives – Minimum 3 credits

GOAL 9: Ethical & Civic Responsibility – Minimum 3 credits

GOAL 10: People & the Environment – Minimum 3 credits
