Social Work General Education Selection Guide

The Bachelor of Social Work degree at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls is fully accredited by the Council on Social Work Education.

Any student may apply to UW-River Falls as a Social Work major; however, the **Social Work program has a formal admission process after enrollment at UW-River Falls**. Since this is normally done during the sophomore year, students should transfer after one or two semesters at Century Community College. Because Social Work students start their major in the first 2 years at UW-River Falls, students who transfer with a full 2 years of college credit (60-64 credits) should expect to take 3 years to finish their degree. Completion of the Associate in Arts Degree before transfer is not advised.

Dr. Rogers, Social Work Chair, is available and encourages interested students to meet with him to discuss transferring to UW-River Falls prior to applying. Students are encouraged to make an appointment with him early.
