CENTURY STUDENTS: The Carlson School of Management offers majors in accounting, finance, international business, marketing, management information systems, finance & risk management & insurance, human resources and industrial relations, entrepreneurial studies, operations, public non-profit, supply chain and operations management.

Admission requirements:

Transfer students should be prepared for a three year undergraduate experience at the Carlson School. Strong consideration is given to students who have the following tool courses completed or in progress spring semester:

- 30 credits
- 3.00 GPA
- Three “tool courses, all with a grade of C- or higher:
 Macroeconomics: Econ 1021
 Microeconomics: Econ1023
 Calculus: Math 1070 or 1081

These courses are recommended for students applying as a junior (Note: acceptance at the junior status is more competitive):

- Acct 2020
- Math 1025 or Econ 2021
- Bmgt 2030

LIBERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

May be met by completing Century's Minnesota Transfer Curriculum or the current AA degree.

If you are completing the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum at Century you may transfer to the University of Minnesota lacking no more than one course in the MnTC and this must be completed during your first semester at the University.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION:

Admission is very competitive and recent overall GPAs have been well over 3.5. Admission is based on a combination of the following criteria (no one criteria will automatically rule out an otherwise strong candidate):

1. Cumulative grade point average in all college coursework, rigor of curriculum and completion patterns.
2. Strong leadership, service and/or work experience
3. Contents of the **application addendum**, which consists of **1-written essay** and a description of activities and accomplishments outside of the classroom. Students may download the Addendum from the Carlson School Website: www.carlsonschool.umn.edu/transfers
4. Students who have less than one year of college work at the time of application will be assessed on their high school work. They must submit their high school transcript and ACT/SAT test scores with their application.
5. Students transferring as sophomores will take statistics and accounting during their first semester at Carlson School.
6. An International experience is required of all students entering Fall 2008 or later. Options include class-based experiences with 2 week abroad component, three week May or January classes, or summer and semester programs and internships.
7. Career Skills, BA 3000, will be required during the summer of students transferring at the junior level. BA 3000 is a tactical skills course, and students who have taken the course during the summer report that it has been valuable in getting them into the internship and career search process immediately in September.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: FALL SEMESTER – MARCH 1st

Carlson admits students for Fall semester only.

(Spring semester courses that are in progress will be considered for admission)

****Students planning on majoring in Accounting will need to take a pre-test prior to Taking Accounting 5101 at Carlson. This pre-test is not an admission requirement.**

Transfer students who are majoring in accounting are required to take and pass a pretest before taking 5101 at the U of M. This is a three hour exam covering fundamentals to solve accounting related business problems. A sample pretest is available for review from the Carlson School Undergraduate Studies Office. Students are strongly encouraged to review the sample pretest prior to the exam. It is recommended that you take the pre-test soon after completing financial accounting. The exam is available each semester. Telephone (612) 624-3313 to schedule the exam. There is no fee for this exam. If you don't pass the test, you may take Accounting 2050 at the U of M, but need an A or B in 2050 to go to 5101. Students are not allowed to retake Accounting 2050 if they don't earn an A or a B after failing the accounting pre-test. Pre-test scores are honored for a two year period after passing the exam.

NOTES:

- Carlson School of Management, at approximately 2200 students, is significantly smaller than Century.
- Vocational/Technical courses and courses numbered below 1000 do not transfer.
- All F's earned in transferable courses are calculated as zero grade points in the student's GPA.
- The Carlson School is increasingly becoming a full-time multi-year experience. Carlson School may not be a good choice for someone working full-time and seeking part-time education. A Carlson degree cannot be completed by taking evening classes.
