Transfer with an Associate of Arts Degree:

Students who transfer to UMD with an [Associate in Arts degree or the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum](#) from Century College will be considered to have met the UMD lower division liberal education requirements. Students should select liberal education courses that are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major or minor degree programs selected. For transfer without an Associate of Arts Degree or MN Transfer Curriculum:

Students should follow the guidelines below:

UMD Liberal Education Program Requirements: At least 35 semester credits are required. One course must be selected from each of the 10 categories. First-year students must complete one course from the Cultural Diversity area and one course from the International Perspective area.

PE Courses: A maximum of 2 credits of physical education courses may be included in the total liberal education credit requirement, but these courses are not applied to any category.

NOTES:

Students who plan to graduate with a BA or BS should also note that they are required to complete a minor or a second major, so they should plan accordingly.

The minimum GPA needed for transfer admission is a 2.0. Some majors may have higher requirements. If a transfer student has not completed 26 transferable credits, a high school transcript and ACT scores will be required.

Priority application deadlines: Fall – March 1st Spring – March 1st Online applications preferred.
