Acceptance to the School of Music as a Music Major requires a voice or instrument audition. Admission is extremely competitive. Audition dates are scheduled yearly by the School of Music. Completed audition applications should be returned at least three weeks before the scheduled audition.

Students applying for a music scholarship must audition by March 1st. Admission to the University and acceptance into the School of Music must be completed before a student may be considered for a music scholarship. School of Music scholarships are based on talent and academic achievement. Application for these awards are to be made to the School of Music and range from \$600 to \$4000. Limited to outstanding students. Deadline for submitting a financial aid application for music scholarships is March 1.
