Dear students currently in the nursing program,

The Century College Nursing Department is announcing that we will be transitioning our associate degree program to a revised curriculum independent of the MN Alliance (MANE) with the first cohort to begin in Fall 2023. This follows a decision by the eight Minnesota State partner institutions to no longer participate in the [MANE Alliance](#).

Currently enrolled students **will not experience any changes** in their curriculum, eligibility to sit for licensure, or potential to continue to a baccalaureate program. Century will continue with the MANE curriculum for current students through Fall 2024. All student students currently enrolled will be able to graduate within the MANE curriculum and be eligible to transfer their courses onto a baccalaureate program, including to Metropolitan State University, as part of MANE. Current students will continue to be eligible to take the NCLEX examination upon successful completion of the program.

Prospective students, not currently enrolled in the nursing program, will be eligible to apply for the new Century nursing program in Spring 2023. More information about the transition and the [new program](#) can be found on the Century college website.
