

Board Policy 3.4 Century College Undergraduate Admissions



Part 1. Purpose

To establish standards that facilitate the admission process for prospective students.

Part 2. Definitions Admission

A student's initial entrance into Century College as a candidate for a certificate, diploma, or degree.

Part 3. Admissions

Students applying for admission to Century College will need to submit their official high school transcript (or GED certificate). High school transcripts should be submitted confirming high school graduation. If an applicant is currently attending high school, they should submit an official high school transcript be submitted following graduation. Century College requires the student to indicate on their FAFSA as well as their application for admission that they either have or will graduate from high school.

If there is reason to believe that a student's high school diploma is not valid or was not obtained from an institution that provides secondary education, Century College will:

1. check with the high school to confirm the validity of the student's diploma; and/or
2. confirm with the relevant department or agency in the state in which the secondary school is located that the secondary school is recognized as a provider of secondary school education.
