- Total BSN Program Credits: 65 nursing & 55 general education= 120 credits**

- * Courses are taken concurrently within the semester.**
- ** Lower division gen ed courses can be taken earlier but not later than the identified semester.**
- ***Upper division Liberal Studies courses may be taken at any time in the plan, dependent upon any pre-requisites.**
- All lower division nursing courses in each semester must be successfully completed to progress to the next semester.
- Upper division NURS courses may be taken in a flexible option plan.**
- Traditional students take NURS 2700, Mobility students take NURS 2720.
